

THE CHAMPIONSHIP PLAYBOOK | PRINCIPLE #7 **SET GOALS**

We can make our plans, but The LORD determines our steps.

Proverbs 16:9, NLT

As someone who's living with Championship Faith and ready to make this your Championship Year, **nothing can set you on the right track like setting goals.**

I love goal setting. I'll get before The LORD with a pad of paper and a pen and get ready to receive! We see this principle clearly defined in The WORD, in Habakkuk:

And The LORD answered me and said, Write the vision and engrave it so plainly upon tablets that everyone who passes may [be able to] read [it easily and quickly] as he hastens by.

For the vision is yet for an appointed time and it hastens to the end [fulfillment]; it will not deceive or disappoint. Though it tarry, wait [earnestly] for it, because it will surely come; it will not be behindhand on its appointed day (Habakkuk 2:2–3, AMPC).

There's something about writing down your goals that makes them real and actionable. As The LORD said to Habakkuk, writing down your vision makes it plain so you can run with it!

But to be clear, your vision is the overall "house" you want to build. Goals are the milestones you need to meet as you build the house.

Here's a goal-setting framework I've found helpful:

- Set your goals with intention. Break them into categories of easy, medium and hard, so you can differentiate between what can be done quickly, and what may take considerable time.
- 2. **Prioritize and plan.** Putting your goals on your calendar makes them actionable. I recommend knocking out a few easy goals to get the momentum going; and then seeing if you can break down your medium and hard goals into smaller, more achievable goals.

3. **Stay consistent.** Celebrate each win, then move on to the next goal. Every step counts!

This is your Championship Year. Put your Championship Faith to work and accomplish more than you ever dreamed possible!
